

FIELD RULES REMINDER — We are back to using our frequency rules we have used in the past. When you arrive, obtain your frequency pm and place your club card in the frequency pin location on the frequency board. This allows us to track the pins should you forget to replace before you leave the field. We still request that when you are not using your transmitter, don't just set it on the flying bench, set it back in the clubhouse impound until you are ready to fly. Please make sure if you are the last to leave the field that the clubhouse door is locked and secure. Try the door after you lock it and replace the key back on the table.

WINTER FLYING TIME — Just a reminder that during November, December, January, February-Saturday, Sunday & Wednesday flying time start is 12:00 Noon. Duck hunters use the adjacent ponds. Let's make sure we comply with this, it's my understanding they will shoot at anything that's flying so you may want to contain the urge to start a little early.

PLANES & PROJECTS \_Since the sky at Carl Henson Field is almost endless, there must be some new plane projects in the works, scratch or ARE we like to see them.
