

Academy of Model Aeronautics National Model Aircraft Safety Code

A resolut aircraft is a non-transmicarrying divice capable of sustained flight within visual time of signr of the griot or spottarry). It may not access at the statement flights within visual intended exclusionshy for sport, accession, education and/er competition. All model flights must be considered in accession time state (code and related AMA gelations) and additional rules specific to the flying site, as well as all applicable laws and regulations.

- As an AMA member Legree:
 - · I will will fly a readel anorall in a careless or reckless manyer
- Even not identifiers with and will yield the right of way to all human-camping around using AMA's See and Avoid Guidance and a spoter when appropriat.
- Evaluation of specialize any model almost while I am under the influence of alcohol or any orugitant could obversely affect my ability to safety control the model.
- Lost avoid frying directly over unprotected people, moving vehicles, and occupied structures
- Twill By Asso Plight (PE) and Control Lew (CL1models in completion with Addics safety programming.
- I will maintain visual contact of an RC model around without enhancement often than interactive times prescribed to An. When using an advanced flight system was as an exteptiol, or flight Entri-Person view (PPv), I will comply with AMA's Advanced Flight System programming.
- Livel only the models weighing more than 35 pounds, including fast, if certified mough AMA's Large Model Argume Program.
- I will only by a Middle-powered model alroad in compliance with AMM's Gas Turbane Program
- I will not fly a powered Wodel outdoors closer than 25 teet to any individual, except for myself or my heavy(x) located at the flightnex, unacc i an taking off and leading, or as otherwise provided in MMV3 Competition Regulation.
- I will use an established safety line to separate all model around operators from operators and buildanders.
