LETTER OF AGREEMENT

EFFECTIVE: AUGUST 18, 2019

SUBJECT: Community Based Organization (CBO) Operational Area

1. PURPOSE: To establish responsibilities and procedures for use of Eugene RC Aeronauts, Inc. CBO operational area.

2. SCOPE: The procedures outlined herein are applicable to Eugene RC Aeronauts CBO and Eugene Airport Traffic Control Tower (EUG) for the safe use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) within Eugene RC Aeronauts CBO approved operational area.

3. CANCELLATION:

a. This agreement is cancelled two (2) years from the effective date of the agreement, or may be terminated by either party upon giving 30 days' advance written notice to the other party.

b. The FAA may immediately terminate or suspend flight operations/this agreement, if the safety of persons or property is compromised or there is a violation of the terms of this agreement.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES: Eugene RC Aeronauts CBO must:

a. Ensure all CBO members and American Modelers Association (AMA) guest pilots are familiar and comply with the procedures in this agreement.

b. Be responsible for all CBO signage located at the Eugene RC Aeronauts Flying Field.

5. PROCEDURES:

a. Operational area is active only during daylight hours (night time operations are not authorized) and defined as follows:

(1) Eugene RC Aeronauts Flying Field is a fixed site located at 92560 Alvadore Rd, Junction City, OR 97448.

(2) Vertical limit: At or below 400 above ground level (AGL).

(3) Lateral boundaries are defined on the attachment.

b. All operations must be contained within the operational area and conform to all current federal, state, and local governmental laws and regulations.


c. Eugene RC Aeronauts, Inc. CBO must immediately notify EUG at 541-607-4630 in the event of a lost link, fly-away or operational area spill-out that may affect manned aircraft operations.

Eugene Airport Traffic Control Tower and Eugene RC Aeronauts, Inc..

d. Eugene RC Aeronauts, Inc. CBO must ensure that EUG has current officer contact and address information.
