

Flying Safety

If you are the first one at the field, open the club house.

That is where the first aid kit and fire extinguisher are.

- 1. Fly with a buddy.
 - a) To spot.
 - b) To assure the field is clear for take-off and landing.
 - c) To assure others on the flight line hear announcements.
 - d) To assist if your plane goes down.
 - e) To assist in starting.
- 2. Follow the flight pattern to avoid mid-air collisions.
- 3. Dead stick has the right of way.
- 4. Do not take-off or land with anyone on the field.
- 5. Announce or pass along.
 - a. Entering runway.
 - b. taking off.
 - c. Dead stick landing.
 - d. Landing.
 - e. On the runway.
- 6. Fly within the boundaries and not over any restricted areas (Mike's house).
- 7. Never fly over or in the direction of the pits.
- 8. Do fly within your skill limitations. We all need to push the envelope a bit, that's how we progress, but pushing it too hard too fast can have nasty results.
- 10. Don't fly the aircraft too far away, it doesn't take long for an RC aircraft to become a tiny dot in the distance, and you have no idea what the aircraft is doing, which way is up.
- 11. Don't turn on a MHz transmitter if you see other modelers around. Check which frequency band they are using first; they also could be using a MHz TX so you need to be aware of the potential clashes.
- 12. Do not taxi in the pit area.

FAA Requires RC Aircraft Registration

Don't forget to renew your AMA membership and register to receive your required FAA number which must be on all your aircraft, the number must be visible without having to dig through the airplane. This applies to any RC aircraft weighing over ½ lb. Also remember that AMA requires that you have your AMA number or your name and address affixed to each aircraft. AMA sells great preprinted labels for your convenience.
