Follow up on Al's meeting with the Fern Ridge Kiwanis

This is a follow-up from my 12/23 meeting with the Fern Ridge Kiwanis Club, a community service organization made up of community and business leaders of the Fern Ridge area. I gave a short presentation on what the Eugene RC Aeronauts are about.

I took a few planes and gear to show and tell about. I began with a brief rundown of our history. I listed many of our community outreach projects and events involving the community. I explained how we are an asset to the local economy and our desire to be a good neighbor. I told of our Introductory Pilot Program to counter any intimidation due to cost or skill level. I also explained the benefits of membership in ERCA as opposed to "going it alone."


